## Note to Educators



There is something so exciting about teaching your own child – seeing their face light up with pride when they learn something new. You have been teaching your child since the day he/she was born and now you are leading them into their first year of school. Congratulations!

A technique we highly recommend as you and your student work through the lesson plans in this curriculum is from ***The Montessori Method***. It is a very effective way to teach names/sounds. There are three steps:

1. Name the object.
2. Ask the child to identify the object.
3. Ask the child to name the object.

If we were to teach a child the letter red, for example, we would use a red crayon or piece of red fabric and do the following:

1. Touch the crayon and say “this is red.” The child should repeat “red”.
2. Ask the child “which crayon is red?” and the child points to the red crayon.
3. Touch the crayon and ask the child “What colour is this?” The child responds “red”.

This method works most effectively with two or three objects. Switch back and forth between them. “This is red. This is green. Which one is red? Which one is green? What colour is this? What colour is this one?”

We wish you all the best as you set off on your teaching adventure!





## ***Phonics (Letter Sounds)***

Before students learn the **names** of letters, they must learn the **sounds**.  
These are called **phonics**.

To teach **phonics**, TWIGS Curriculum has joined each letter sound to an English word that begins with that sound. Each student should learn the word and sound as a unit, as in:  
Ah Ah Apple. Buh Buh Butterfly. Cuh Cuh Cat.

The word-sound pairs used by TWIGS are below, with alternative words in (parentheses).

- A - Apple
- B - Butterfly (bag, bird)
- C - Cat
- D - Dinosaur (dog, day)
- E - Elephant (egg)
- F - Fish
- G - Goat (garden, gate, girl)
- H - House (hat, head)
- I - Inside (insect, in)
- J - Jam (Jesus, jump)
- K - Kite (kitchen)
- L - Light
- M - Mother (man, monkey)

## ***Phonics (Letter Sounds)***

Instead of teaching phonics/letter sounds in alphabetical order, this curriculum uses the most effective letter order.

Teaching phonics in this order allows students to begin building words immediately and also separated easily-confused letters such as 'b' and 'd'.

The letter order used by TWIGS Curriculum is:

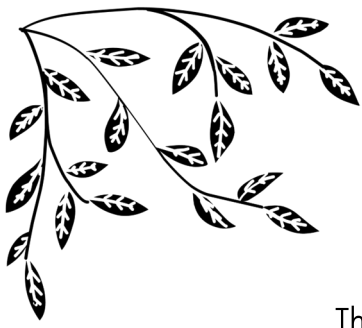

# ***Reading***

There is a 'reading' section at the end of each daily schedule.  
Specific books/stories have been recommended but are not required.

It is very important to read picture books aloud to young children as this gets them excited about reading in the future. Any books that you have available and can read aloud (but especially books with colourful pictures) will benefit your students.

## **Some notes:**

- 'Storybook Bible' refers to *The Jesus Storybook Bible* by Sally Lloyd Jones
- When reading a book aloud, hold it facing the class and read by looking down at the pages, so that the children can see the pictures as you read.
- Rhyming books are especially helpful for young children to hear.



# *Learning through Play*



Children in Preschool/Kindergarten/Grade 0 learn many things by playing with educational toys. Playing helps strengthen their muscles and improves their motor skills and coordination. Children learn to grasp, hold, pick up, and manipulate small objects in preparation for later tasks.

Some educational toys you can make at home for your child to play with are:

## ***Beads***

You can make beads out of many things. Collect plastic bottle lids, small pieces of cardboard, wires or strings. Then:

Make a hole through the top of each lid

Cut the cardboard into circles or squares and make a hole through the center of each shape

Twist the wire into a small ring and fold over any sharp edges

Braid/plait the string and then tie it into a ring.

Your student can practice stringing these homemade beads on shoelaces to improve their coordination and fine motor skills.

## ***Wooden Blocks***

Stacking wooden blocks into towers improves coordination while also introducing your child to some important concepts they will learn more about later in life. Playing with blocks also gives your child a chance to use his/her imagination: she can build a tower or a house or a kitchen or a farm...the options are endless.

Wooden blocks do not have to be fancy. Use wood off-cuts; any small pieces of wood with at least two flat sides can be stacked or used in building. Collect wood pieces of all shapes and sizes to make them more interesting to play with.

## ***Toy Loom***

Teach your child to weave strings with a toy loom. This can be made very easily out of cardboard and string.

- Cut a square, round or rectangular piece of cardboard.
- Cut small notches all around the edges of the shape.
- Wrap strings lengthwise across the shape.
- Your child can now practice weavings strings under-and-over on their toy loom.





## ***Dolls, animals or cars***

Children learn about their world by imitating the actions of adults. They like playing with dolls because they get to be the parent and practice parenting skills (feeding, carrying, soothing, singing to, and playing with a baby).

In the same way, they like playing with toy animals and cars as a way to imitate their world.

- You can make toy dolls or animals out of fabric scraps, wood, straw or wire.
- Toy cars can be made out of wire, wood or cardboard.

## ***Lacing Cards***

A lacing card is a good way for students to improve their fine motor skills and practice tying their shoes.

- Cut out the lacing card templates included in the Teacher's Guide.
- Trace each template onto cardboard and cut out the shapes.
- Make holes all around the edges of each shape.
- Your student can use a shoelace to practice lacing/sewing all around the edges of each shape.

## ***Everyday Objects***

Many items in your house or garden can be used for Learning Through Play. Some ideas are:

- **Nuts and bolts** – your child can practice screwing and unscrewing the bolts onto the nuts.
- **Padlocks and keys** – teach your child to unlock and lock a padlock.
- **Pots and Pans** – give your child an old pot or pan and other dishes to play “kitchen” with.
- **Tools** – child-safe, smaller versions of tools like a hammer, broom, shovel, or hoe are useful for children to learn practical skills.
- **Pebble Path**
  - \* Collect smooth stones with at least one flat surface.
  - \* Clean the stones.
  - \* Draw a wavy line on each stone, from one side to the other.
  - \* Your student can line up the stones so that the lines connect to each other to form a “path”.

## ***Plaiting/Braiding Board***

- Collect thick strings, ribbons, or strips of fabric.
- Attach them to a small board or piece of cardboard in sets of three.
- Teach your child to plait/braid the strings together.



## ***Floor Numbers***

One simple way to teach your child to recognize numbers is by lining up numbers 0 to 10 on the floor and having him/her jump on each number as you count.

Some ideas to make "floor numbers" are:

1. Sew pieces of fabric together to make a rectangle the size of a piece of bond paper, then cut out each number in a different color and sew it onto each rectangle.
2. Collect large, flat stones and paint or write each number on a stone; line them up like stepping stones for your child to jump on.
3. Write the numbers on bond paper and lay them flat on the floor.
4. Write the numbers on pieces of cardboard and lay them on the floor.
